## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- If you have even mild symptoms please stay at home and get tested.
- Attendees are encouraged to download the COVIDSafe app @ <https://www.health.gov.au/resources/apps-and-tools/covidsafe-app>
- Entries are restricted to residents of NSW and ACT only.
- Visitors shall not be permitted to attend this event. A visitor is deemed to be a person who does not own an exhibit entered at the event or is not a member of the household of an entered exhibitor.
- All persons MUST register their attendance at the office. Wrist band to be issued and worn each day.
- Failure to adhere to any instruction issued by an Official shall result in the exhibitor being required to immediately leave the grounds and they shall be reported to Dogs NSW.
- \* Entries will be capped at 400 per day
- There will be limited paper catalogues issued at this event. On day purchase is \$10, pre ordered \$5
- There shall be no place ribbons available at this event.
- Catalogue will be online one hour prior to the commencement of the show.
- Lapel card numbers will be emailed to exhibitors. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to print their own lapel exhibit numbers.
- For exhibitors unable to print numbers they shall obtain some from the office
- Gazebos must be spaced a minimum of 1.5 metres apart.
- Exhibitors must vacate the Showground within 30 minutes of being eliminated from competition.

## PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Total numbers shall not exceed the NSW Government Gazetted COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement Order current at the time of the show.
- There shall be no congregating in gazebos that you are not responsible for.
- Keep a distance of 1.5 metres between yourself and other people.
- Do not shake hands, hug or kiss as a greeting.
- Practise good hygiene by cleaning your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds with soap and water, or sanitizer, after visiting a common area, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- No person shall encroach into the Steward's designated safety zone.
- Masks may be worn by Officials and Exhibitors- but are not compulsory.
- \* Participants must be prepared to be self-sufficient; bring your own hand sanitizer, face masks, chairs.
- Hand sanitiser can be purchased from the office.
- All Vendors and Patrons shall adhere to physical distancing rules.
- Exhibitors must avoid touching dogs that are not their responsibility.
- Exhibitors and Officials shall not use common pens & pencils or tables and chairs.
- Exhibitors shall enter the ring area via the entrance and depart via the exit maintaining physical distancing at all times.
- Ring equipment shall be regularly sanitised during the event. Please avoid touching equipment.
- A volunteer shall be engaged to maintain hygienic conditions in restrooms.
- Exhibitors are requested to be considerate of fellow exhibitors and maintain appropriate hygiene and physical distancing when visiting restrooms.

**JUDGING**

- Exhibitors shall stand at arm's-length from their exhibit as it is being examined by the Judge. (This will assist in providing the requisite 1.5 metre physical distancing.)
- The exhibitor shall be responsible for mouthing the exhibit.
- Judges are encouraged to spend no more than 15 seconds going over an individual exhibit.
- Judges are encouraged to examine exhibits at arms-length to facilitate physical distancing.
- Where there is more than one entry in a class, exhibitors must adhere to physical distancing rules.
- Judges must wash/sanitise their hands between each exhibit.
- When judging Group Specials, Judges are encouraged to reduce the number of exhibitors required in the ring at any one time by: •••• Running dogs individually and shortlisting the Group or Classes in Group.
