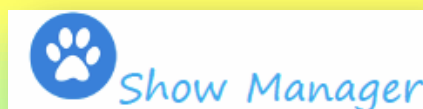

Welcome exhibitors to the 2020 shows of The Australian Working Dog Club of NSW Inc. We have in place a number of rules for the safe running of our two shows on Sunday 11 October 2020 and we thank you ahead of time for your co-operation.

The wearing of face masks whilst competing is for the safety primarily of our judges and steward for without their consent to judge we would not be able to run our shows.

When entering this show please ensure you have read and adhere to the below.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- If you have even mild symptoms please stay at home and get tested.
- Attendees are encouraged to download the COVIDSafe app @ <https://www.health.gov.au/resources/apps-and-tools/covidsafe-app>
- Entries are restricted to residents of NSW and ACT only.
- Every person attending the shows must register their full name and telephone contact. Show Manager will include a mandatory contact sheet to be completed with your entry.
- All entries, including Property classes must be entered on-line via Show Manager.
- A volunteer shall be engaged to act as our Safety Marshall. They will maintain hygienic conditions in restrooms, in and around the ring area and be responsible for the documentation of such details of persons attending.
- Failure to adhere to any instruction issued by an Official or Safety Marshall shall result in the exhibitor being required to immediately leave the grounds and they shall be reported to Dogs NSW.
- There will be no paper catalogues issued at this event. A copy of each shows catalogue will be posted for viewing near the ring. Catalogue for both shows will be online and available 1 hour prior to the commencement of the first show.
- Lapel card numbers will be emailed to exhibitors. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to print their own lapel exhibit numbers.
- Gazebos must be spaced a minimum of 1.5 metres apart.
- No camping on grounds

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Total numbers shall not exceed the NSW Government Gazetted COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement Order current at the time of the show.
- Keep a distance of 1.5 metres between yourself and other people.
- Do not shake hands, hug or kiss as a greeting.
