COVID 19 PLAN, for 28th March 2021, 30th
Anniversary Specialty Championship Show.

1. ALL Gazebos to be set up 1.5m apart.
2. Only persons required to handle exhibits, to be in any 1 gazebo, masks to be worn if unable to socially distance.
3. No persons to congregate around ring entrance.
4. Markers to be used in the exhibition ring, for exhibits, exhibitors to adhere to a 2m or more distance, for run offs.
5. Markers to be used in marshalling area.
6. Exhibitors to wear masks, whilst the judge is going over their exhibit (these may be removed after appraisal). Exhibitors may be required to mouth their exhibits.
7. Stewards will be required to wear a mask, if unable to socially distance.
8. Hand sanitizer to be supplied and stationed, at all corners of the exhibition area, and also

for the judge and stewards use, inside on the judges table.

9. In classes that are larger than 6 exhibits, the class will be split for judging, and the judge will call back, only those he/she requires to make their final choice. (This is for classes only, Challenge line up to be judged as normal)
10. Strictly no hand shaking
11. This is subject to government Covid rules in place at the time of the show.
