- After the awarding of Challenge, Best of Breed and Best in Group ensure the judge is aware of whether or not there is anything to return. Don't assume the judge will know there is an exhibit to return. It is too late when the judge announces the award before an eligible exhibit has returned. Once a class has been judged it cannot be re-judged. (Reg. 231)

Also Reg. 128: *Once a judge has commenced judging a class no other exhibit can enter the ring for that class. A class cannot be re-judged.*

- Reg. 224.3: *Not more than one (1) exhibit number shall be displayed at any one time and under no circumstances shall an exhibit be judged without the handler clearly displaying its correct exhibit number.*

I feel sure that it would be appreciated by most stewards if exhibitors also would keep this regulation in mind and not ask if it is okay to go in the ring without the exhibit number making a refusal necessary.
