## AGE CLASSIFICATIONS FOR ENTERING SHOWS

Age Classifications are set out below and are effective for all Exhibitions

Dogs	Bitches
1 Baby Puppy	1A 3 months and under 6 months
2 Minor Puppy	2A 6 months and under 9 months
3 Puppy	3A 6 months and under 12 months
4 Junior	4A 9 months and under 18 months
5 Intermediate	5A 18 months and under 36 months
9 State Bred	9A 6 months and over whelped in SA
10 Australian Bred	10A 6 months and over whelped in Australia
14 Bred By Exhibitor	14A 6 months and over - Owned, Bred, Handled by Breeder
11 Open	11A 6 months and over

FURTHERMORE, due to confusion sometimes arising over the correct calculation of a dog's age into breed classes where the date of birth does not occur in the relevant month, the anniversary date is to be taken as the last date of that month, e.g. dogs born on the 31<sup>st</sup> January will be eligible to enter the Baby Puppy class on the 30<sup>th</sup> April

## DOGS SA POLICIES FOR PHOTOGRAPHERS AT DAVID ROCHE PARK

- Any person is permitted to take photographs on the grounds providing they are not selling such photographs
- Any person who intends to take photographs on the grounds for remuneration must supply proof of Public Liability Insurance to the office
- Any person who intends to have a site on the grounds for either displaying and or the taking of photographs must pay the appropriate site fee
- Clubs who engage a photographer to take photographs on their behalf have the right to make that photographer exclusive for their event and no other photographers are then permitted to operate during that Clubs event/s for commercial gain.
